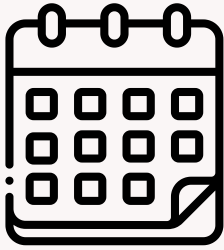


# Cross Timbers Master Naturalists

## Important Dates

Application Due Date: June 30, 2023

Training Dates: Every Tuesday from 8/15-10/24,  
Saturdays - 9/9, 9/23, 10/7, 10/14, 10/22



Most classes will be held at the **Fort Worth Nature Center**. The first class will be at the **Fort Worth Botanic Garden**. Field trips will be at various locations.



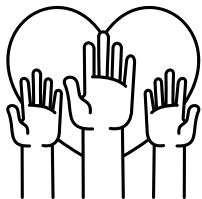
There are 4 units in the class: **Aquatics, Forest, Prairie, and Urban**. Each unit addresses plant and animal life found in the ecosystem. The teachers are local naturalists who are knowledgeable and friendly. You are NOT expected to be an expert! All you need is a readiness to learn!



Training fee is **\$150**. Price of textbook & dues through 2024 are included. Some partial scholarships are available.



If you **miss a class or field trip**, you will need to complete the make-up training within 12 months.



You need **40 Volunteer hours and 8 Advanced Training (AT) Hours** to **certify**. You can start volunteering and counting hours after the first class.

All hours must be completed in Tarrant or Parker county for initial certification. These hours must be completed by the end of 2024.
