If you painted a canoe or critter, please bring it to the April meeting.

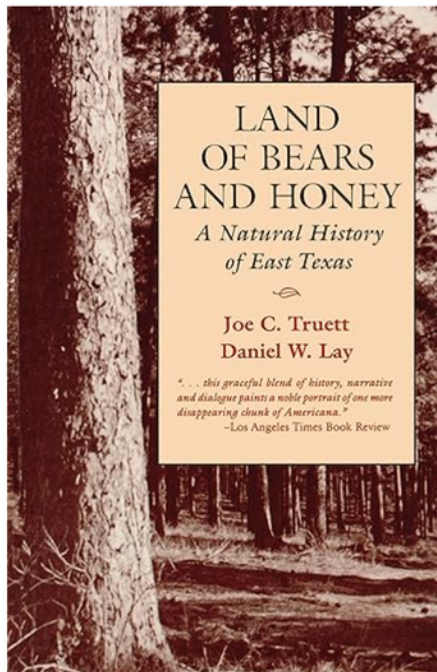


APRIL MEETING- APRIL 14TH AT 6PM

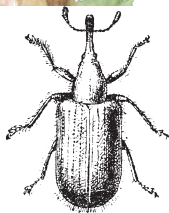
CYPRESS BASIN MEMBER ACHIEVES 5000 HOUR MILESTONE

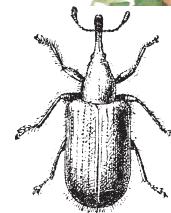
2025 TRAINING CLASS ANNOUNCEMENT
