The studies from this project were in support in collaboration with Texas A&M Agrilife Research Center in Dallas. Our contact there is Kimberly Scofield, an Urban Entomologist by training. Our studies included trapping red wasps on several youth camps (two YMCA and two Girl Scouts) and subsequent testing of methods for control of those pests chemical and physical. Several scientific and trade publication papers were published based on these studies. We even tried painting the eaves of camp cabins in an effort to keep wasps from building their nests there (blue works better than gray, green, brown, or salmon).
