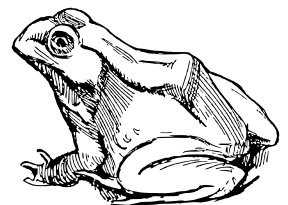
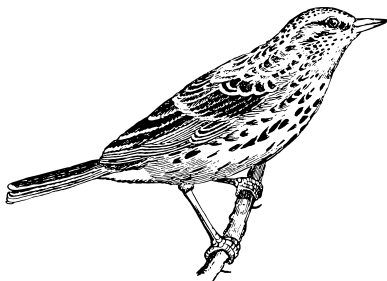
The in-person happens at the Williamson County Annex, 100 Wilco Way, Georgetown, TX 78626, and registration is open to all.
