Location:

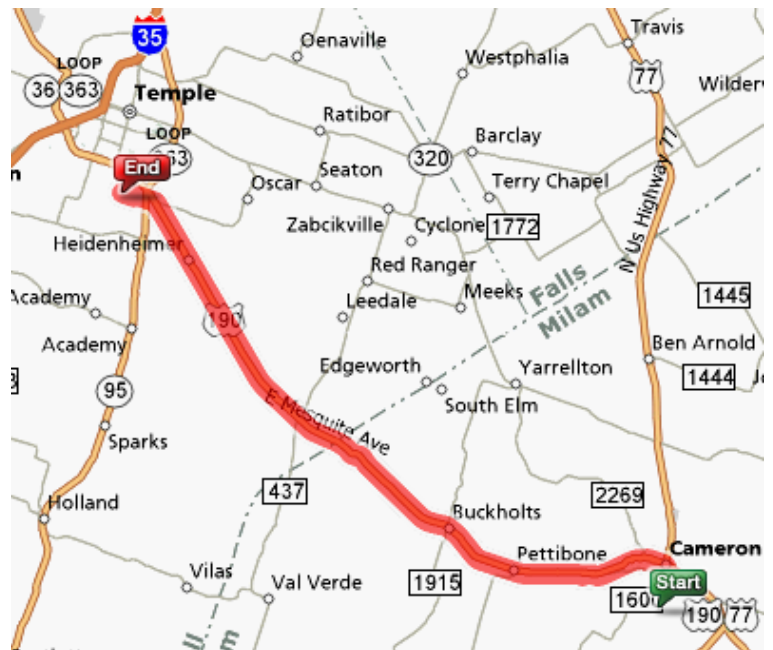
35 miles / 31 minutes northwest of Cameron
