Location:

53 miles / 58 minutes southeast of Cameron

56 miles / 59 minutes southeast of Rockdale

Directions from Rockdale:

1. Take US 79 east to Hwy 6 at Hearne, then turn right and go south.
2. Take the Hwy 6 East Bypass around Bryan/College Station, and exit at Hwy 60 (University Drive).
3. Turn left onto Hwy 60 and drive approximately one mile.
4. Turn right at the Texas A&M University sign and drive about a quarter of a mile through the wooded park to the University Services Building. The TCWC is located in the southeast corner (Room 128) of the building. Look for the double glass doors and entrance ramp.
