| <b>METAL</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Aluminum and Steel/Tin</b> beverage and food cans</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>RINSE</b> and <b>FLATTEN</b></li> </ul>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><del>X</del> Aluminum foil or trays</li> <li><del>X</del> Aerosol cans</li> <li><del>X</del> Helium tanks</li> </ul>   |
| <b>PAPER</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Newspapers</b> including inserts that come inside the newspaper</li> <li><b>Glossy Magazines/Catalogs</b></li> <li><b>All Corrugated Cardboard</b> (with wavy middle)</li> <li><b>Office Paper</b> (white or colored)</li> <li><b>Phone Books</b></li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep <b>CLEAN</b> and <b>DRY</b></li> <li><b>REMOVE</b> pastic sleeves and rubber bands</li> <li>Please break down boxes if possible</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><del>X</del> Yellowed, dirty, wet or moldy paper</li> <li><del>X</del> Paperboard such as shoe, cereal and soda boxes</li> <li><del>X</del> Colored construction paper</li> <li><del>X</del> Shredded paper</li> </ul>                                   |
| <b>CELL PHONES &amp; E-WASTE</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Old Cell Phones and Phone Batteries</b></li> <li>Batteries able to be recharged <i>i.e.</i> from cordless phones, radios, cordless tools, digital/video cameras, laptop computers, 2-way radios, remote toys, printer cartridges, etc.</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep separate from other material</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><del>X</del> Phone accessories (chargers, adaptors, headsets, etc.)</li> <li><del>X</del> Single-use batteries</li> <li><del>X</del> Auto/boat batteries</li> <li><del>X</del> Computer or accessories</li> <li><del>X</del> Home Electronics</li> </ul> |

### Used Oil & Oil Filters

### Fats, Oils and Grease Recycling

The City of Bryan offers recycling for fats, oils and greases from your kitchen. This service is offered at the same location as oil recycling.

*"Don't pour it down the drain, recycle it."*

### Tires

The City of Bryan *Drive-In* Recycling Center also accepts tires from *Bryan residents only!!*





*Please follow these guidelines:*

- Must bring a current BTU Utility Bill & matching driver's license
- No rims allowed
- Limit 8 tires/year

*Once per year every Bryan resident is eligible to earn a **FREE** month's of garbage service.*

-  Bring your most recent utility bill to the recycling center when you recycle.
-  A stamp will be placed on your bill by one of the *Drive-In* Staff.
-  Save **12 MONTHS** of stamps and return all receipts with the stamps to the recycling center.
-  A voucher is issued verifying your free garbage service and a credit will appear on a future utility bill. Look for the word "*Adjustment*"- this will be your credit. *Please allow up to 45 days for the credit to appear on your bill.*
