DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO ROUNDUP

The building is at 2801 North I-35, Denton 76207 for those with GPS or Googling the map. On the front south end of the building is BEN E. KEITH sign. On the front north end of the building is BUDWEISER sign. Please DO NOT park in any area and/or spot where there is a 'name'. Additional parking is available in the south parking lot.

Coming in on Hwy 380 from east or west turn south on North I-35 and stay on the service road. After passing Oak Street, the building will be on your right.

Coming in on I-35E or I-35w go north all the way to the Hwy 380 exit. After exiting there, make the u-turn back to the south under the bridge. Stay on the service road. After passing Oak Street, the building will be on your right. This is a bit out of the way, but offers the least opportunity for getting lost.
