New Category There is a new category for video entry this year:

- › **Who is a Master Naturalist Video** – can be composed of oral history interview videos from 20th Anniversary project, interviews of current members or from new class members.

Video Must Have's:

- › Videos must feature the Texas Master Naturalist program or several elements of the Program (TMN members, members wearing TMN gear, clear mention of your TMN chapter and program are all great examples)
- › Videos must reference (or be willing to add reference to) the TMN Program state partners of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension and the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department.
