Spend the day with us at the beautiful Acton Nature Center and learn the life cycle of the amazing Monarch butterfly. The king of the butterflies is currently migrating from southern Canada to the mountains of central Mexico. We will introduce you to the Monarch Watch Program which has studied this incredible butterfly for twenty years. Your journey will include 5 education stations; monarch life cycle, monarch crafts, migration, a puddling activity and the actual capture and release of live butterflies. Volunteers will assist you with how to gently capture and tag Monarchs. How do they know where Mexico is? Come find out!
