Election Process

Nomination. The Officer Nominating Committee, chaired by the Past-President


with a minimum of two additional ad-hoc members who are selected by the President with Board approval, shall submit a slate of candidates for Officers to the President. The President must publish the slate to the Chapter membership in writing 15 days prior to the last General Membership Meeting before the end of each calendar year.

State Coordination. The State Master Naturalist Coordinator(s) may provide oversight and additional input to an individual Chapter's nomination process. Nominations from the Floor. Nominations for all positions will be accepted from the floor prior to a vote at the last General Membership Meeting of the calendar year.

Election. The election shall take place by secret ballot, or as stated in the local Chapter Operating Handbook, at the last General Membership Meeting of the calendar year and winners determined by a simple majority.

Single Candidate. If only one candidate is nominated for an office, that candidate may be elected by voice vote.

Assumption of Office. The newly elected Officers shall assume their duties within the month of January of the following calendar year.

Meeting notes for New Class Committee November 17, 2020

Training is going well with the Initial training. Michelle has certified and recertified. Tom and Marie have finished there initial training and are now interns, but still lack some volunteer hours, 4 others have enough hours that they should finish the initial training at our next raining session this weekend, and some others are lagging but we have several more trainings scheduled. Since the last meeting we have trained at Mustang Island, had a virtual meeting about reptiles and amphibians in the area, had a virtual meeting dealing with the geology of the Nueces river system, attended virtual cold Stunned turtle training, and had a great training at Nueces Delta including familiarization with reptiles.

The committee has continued meeting to finish planning for this session of training which will end in January.. We will be finishing at Oso Bay Wetlands and learning center, Lake Corpus Christ State Park, a virtual meeting with Welder Wildlife refuge, and finally at Aransas National wildlife refuge.

They are working on preparing the training schedule for next year. Hopefully we will be able to go back to our August through January in person training. However we will continue with our virtual training as some things can be taught well in a virtual setting. We are also able to introduce our training sites and the personnel from each site who will be assisting us ahead of the visit..

Randy has programed the Website to produce a training section with tabs where all the material from each training session is stored there under the name of the site we visited.
