This year's event will mark the Texas Master Naturalist Program's 17th Annual Meeting and will be the 18th year of the program. This year's meeting will be held on the edge of the East Texas pineywoods, where the pines and the metropolis of Houston meet. La Torretta Lake Resort & Spa on the shores of Lake Conroe, with award winning amenities, a grand conference center and critically acclaimed banquet services, will play host to the Master Naturalists as they engage in educational training opportunities throughout the weekend. The Annual Meeting provides an opportunity for the Texas Master Naturalist volunteers from around the state to gather, participate in hands-on educational seminars, and receive all of their Advanced Training requirements for the year within one weekend. It's also an opportunity for program participants and supporters to network, share new ideas/projects, and to learn from different chapters from different regions of the state.

There will be ample time throughout the conference for attendees to browse the vendor areas, with breaks and socials scheduled to be held in the vendor space. The money raised from the silent auction will be used to pay for scholarships for Master Naturalists from each chapter to be able to attend our conference the following year. The mission of the Texas Master Naturalist program is to *develop a corps of well-informed volunteers to provide education, outreach, and service dedicated to the beneficial management of natural resources and natural areas within their communities for the State of Texas.*
