A Brief History

- June 17, 2014 – our first look at the Samaritan VMS system
- October, 2014 – Heart of TX went online
- January, 2015 – Ack!
- February, 2015 – Uploads begin – people & hours
- January, 2016 we finished our uploads and training...



2016...

- 10,624 Volunteers in the system
 - 4,570 Active, In Training, Not Eligible
 - 5,857 Inactive
 - 166 Interested in joining our next classes
- 3,545,058 Service Hours
- 485,118 AT Hours
- 46,368 Initial Training Hours
- 212,530 Records



Today...

- 11,672 Volunteers in the system
 - 4,948 Active, In Training, Not Eligible
 - 6,354 Inactive
 - 276 Interested in joining our next classes
- 3,864,480 Service Hours
- 530,581 AT Hours
- 72,921 Initial Training Hours



What are we doing with the Data?

- Federal Reports are a snap.
 - Outside Agency/Partner reports are a breeze.
- All without bothering the chapters**

Other Benefits

- We're all on the same page
- Our data is more reliable and consistent
- The audits that we just completed were outstanding



Changes we've made since the last Annual Meeting

- Impact Data – the Grand Total was removed
 - We didn't have a way to automate the total. The Grand Total can be calculated after we export the data.
- CMOP Updates
- New Reporting Class
- eCoordinator: added Active Opportunities Search
- CBCs – We're watching them all the time
- Water Specialization – Only one AT opportunity, Service opportunities have the check box.
- Added TMN-Advisor status
- Completed our second 'Audit'



2016 Audit Results

- Average 79 projects per chapter
- Average 105 Active/In Training volunteers per chapter
- Wrong Opportunity Type on LBE – virtually eliminated with the survey change in April
- Removed approvals from a lot of Inactive volunteers
- Fixed a ton of Opportunity Organization Contact information.
- Volunteer Current Chapter is actually ‘Current’ or ‘Last’



2017 Audit Results

- Average 88 projects per chapter, 68 are 'Active'
- Average 101 Active/In Training volunteers per chapter
- Stats for 2016
 - 71.6% of Active Volunteers put in hours
 - 68.1% of Active Opportunities have hours recorded
 - 82% of Active Volunteers have their profiles complete for their CBC
 - Should the 18% be TMN-Inactive?
 - 7% of entries were put in after the 45 day cutoff
 - 1% of entries were put in before their start date
 - The average time to approve an LBE is 21 days
- Common Issues
 - Opportunity Approvals for TMN-Inactive volunteers
 - When approving volunteers/opportunities, use the named searches.
- Impact Data
 - We know – it's a pain... but AgriLife needs the data
 - Be sure that you aren't double counting people – only one person needs to put in the data for each event.

 - 8 eRecruiter Items
 - 12 eCoordinator Items
 - 8 Survey Items



What We Want To Do

The Top 5 TXMN Development Items

- Dashboard: Fix the hours summary to show TMN Hours
- eRecruiter Logbook: Offer a Chronological listing
- eRecruiter Logbook: Printing/Export Capability
- Survey: The ability to grab more information from the opportunity or volunteer profile.
- eCoordinator: The ability to move a LBE from one opportunity to another.
